**Minutes of Annual Parish Meeting**

**1) Apologies**

**2) Minutes of the Previous Meeting:-** The Minutes of the Meeting held 11<sup>th</sup> May 2010 were approved by the meeting, having previously been circulated, and were signed as a true record.

**3) Welcome by Chairman and Chairman's Report:-** The Chairman opened the meeting and thanked everyone for their attendance. The year had started with the service to rededicate the Cairn on the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. of its dedication. The 2011 V.E. Day celebrations had just been held and again were well attended. Thanks were give to all the helpers who had made the day a success especially the Padre who had travelled all the way from Cranwell to conduct the service. The Mitchener award had been presented to Katie Knott. Support had been given to the Playing Field Committee throughout the year by means of grass cutting etc. A bench had been presented to Montcony in October and a brass plaque was to be placed on it shortly. The Council were continuing to try and provide allotments in the village and discussions were ongoing. The Hydro Scheme had been finally approved subject to certain conditions being met and the Council welcomed the decision. Finally there was to be a Hercules Aircraft from 426 Squadron visiting the RAF Camp later this month.

**4) County Councillor's Report:-** In the absence of Cllr. Patmore no report received.

**District Councillor's Report:-** Chris Rooke the new District Cllr. introduced himself and gave details of his background Whilst as a new Cllr. he was unable to present a formal report for the year he would try to present feedback from the District Council whenever possible. He had been returned unopposed and the political balance on H.D.C. remained unchanged. Cllr. Marston thanked him for his comments.

**5) Parish Council Accounts to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010:-** The Parish Clerk presented the Accounts for the Parish for the year to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2011 which were approved by the meeting.

**6) Reports from Parish Councillors:-** No reports received.

**7) Any Other Reports:-**

**Report from the School Governors:-** Derrick Jauncey as Chair of the Governors reported that the School had been recognised as outstanding by OFSTED in every category which was most unusual and underlined the strong team lead by Mrs Burke the head teacher. The investment by N.Y.C.C. of £260K to provide a new classroom had been completed although some snagging would have to be carried out in the summer. The Contractors had donated £500 to school funds. The children would be able to swim this year as the pool was fully repaired. Over £1000 had been raised at the Spring Fair. Children from the school had once again supported the V.E. Day celebrations. The Chairman thanked Mr Jauncey for his report.

**Report from RAF Community Support :-** Mrs Hutchinson reported that over 1500 individual pieces of activity had taken place over the year with the Summer Ball being a particular success with over 500 children and their parents attending. Activities had included Football Dance and Trampoline Courses. The youth workers were now in post and already making a difference. The Chairman thanked Mrs Hutchinson for her report.

**8) Comments and Questions from Members of the Public:-**

S Powers reported that he had removed the heavy duty catch to the playing field gate as small children were having difficulty opening it. It would be replaced with a return spring. Further planting had been carried out at Mill Corner which was now known as Tiggs Corner.
