17-104 Public Forum

17-104.1 The new Head of Linton Primary School attended the start of the meeting and expressed a keenness to forge links between the PC and the school.

17-104.2 A member of public attended to report an issue on Beech Tree Court with the backing up of sewage. YW has been contacted by PC Clerk in February 2016 and April 2017 regarding the matter. The resident has also been in contact with YW who have allegedly indicated they will only address the issue if they get funding. Several phone calls regarding the complaint were made to the former Parish Clerk in May, June and July 2017. The case was closed by Michael Denny of YW 3 July 2017.

RESOLVED: The Clerk resolves to forward historic correspondence to resident.

17-104.3 Hannah Kelly and Jon Caffrey spoke to the PC to propose a Community Speed Watch initiative in Linton. This is a NYP initiative, with responsibility being given to local communities to maintain the programme after being given training. If given go ahead would take 1 to 2 months to establish.
