19-003 To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting as true and correct

The Minutes of the Meeting held on Tuesday 11th December 2018, having been previously circulated, were approved and signed by the Chairman.

19-004 Actions from Previous Meeting

18-138.9 YW response - Clerk has written to Yorkshire Water again to ask for dates that drains were inspected and to confirm there is still concern on this front

RESOLVED: Clerk to contact YW again with continuing issues including capacity and to ask for reports/ feedback when YW next visit.

19-005 Public Forum

A member of the public was present to discuss the continuing problems with drainage/ sewage in the village; the MoP had spoken to a YW operative who was in the area looking at the system and asked them about what they were doing, they informed the MoP that the main sewer was half full. There is a concern that there are empty houses at moment and if these become occupied there will be more issues as the sewers fill.

RESOLVED: Cllr Flatekval to approach residents of area to ask if they have problems.

Another MoP confirmed 12 May as VE day.

Wg Cdr Howard Newbold attended to discuss RAF Linton station closure procedure. Planning is still provisional so some things might change. They will stop flying Tucanos 31/10/19, most personnel will be redeployed so fewer military personnel on base. Aircraft will be disposed of, probably by middle of 2020. Tutors will continue flying until end of 2020, then air base will be closed. The station will then have a year to close down after that (2021). It is not known what will happen after that. The married living quarters not controlled by RAF, and it is likely they will still be used.

Memorial room and heritage items – these are of interest to many people and Linton are still considering what to do with everything. Items on loan have to be returned; and people from RAF museums will look at what is left and will determine if anything of interest to National museum. Some items are very specific to Linton, so not sure what will happen to these. Wg Cdr Howard is looking at what is best done with these. When what is left is determined he will be in contact to discuss possibilities. Questions – how long will children’s activities carry on for? For as long as possible; Patrick Lewis Brown staying to carry on community activities. No definite plans, depends on demand. Who will be in charge of security? Same as now until end 2021, not sure after that. The current housing may be opened up to civilians which would have an impact. What about the links with Montcony and history group? Open to discussion on how to sort that.

Wg Cdr Howard ended the report by saying he would be happy to answer questions in future.
